ROMANS 8:18-25

For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory that is to be revealed to us. For the creation waits with eager longing for the revealing of the sons of God. For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of him who subjected it, in hope that the creation itself will be set free from its bondage to corruption and obtain the freedom of the glory of the children of God.

For we know that the whole creation has been groaning together in the pains of childbirth until now. And not only the creation, but we ourselves, who have the first fruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies. For in this hope we were saved. Now hope that is seen is not hope. For who hopes for what he sees? But if we hope for what we do not see, we wait for it with patience.

2 CORINTHIANS 5:17-21

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here! All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God. God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

REVELATION 21:1-5

Then I saw "a new heaven and a new earth," for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea. I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband. And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Look! God's dwelling place is now among the people, and he will dwell with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. 'He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death' or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away."

He who was seated on the throne said, "I am making everything new!" Then he said, "Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true."

FILMMAKER DIVISIONS

FILMMAKERS MAY SUBMIT WORK IN ONE OF THESE DIVISIONS

PROFESSIONAL DIVISION

Career professionals - artists who regularly receive compensation for their artistic works (more than \$5000/year)

ARTIST COMMUNITY

Any nonprofessional filmmaker above the age of 18

SCHOLAR

Nonprofessional filmmakers ages 12-18 as of March 2012

INSPIRATION STATEMENT

As part of your submission you will be asked to write an inspiration statement (500 characters or less) that describes how your entry fits the theme of ALL THINGS NEW.

What scriptures inspired you to write what you wrote? How did God speak to you during this time? How does your film express that.

This statement will be used by the committee during the selection process.

ELIGIBILITY & GUIDELINES

This exhibition is open to all filmmakers who are able to attend the events associated with the exhibition. Specifically if your work is selected to be shown during the Film Festival Event March 30th. There is no fee for entry. All films must be original in concept and creation. No copies of other's work will be accepted. Rights subject to copyright laws must have documentation that you have the proper releases and/or licenses to use that material. Minors (those under 18 before March 30th) will need to obtain parental permission to participate in the festival.

Each film submitted must be accompanied by a short inspiration statement in PDF format. Entries will be accepted between Feb 1 and Feb 29. Films must be uploaded to a password protected Vimeo account and the access information submitted on the entry form. If you have questions about how to use Vimeo email us at mustardtreearts@gmail.com. Films should be less than 10 minutes in length. They may be documentary, narrative, animated, or experimental in nature.

You will be asked to release rights for Fellowship Bible Church and/or Mustard Tree Arts to use your work during the festival, church services, and posting on the websites associated with the festival and in the promotion of future festivals. We may also make a compilation work which will include your submitted work. You retain full ownership of your film.

JUDGING & AWARDS

All films submitted will be judged for acceptance into the festival by the Mustard Tree Arts Festival Filmmakers Committee and sent to the Judge (to be announced) for selection of the top entries.

Awards will be for the top winner in each division:

Professional: \$200 for first place, award ribbons for second and third place
Artist Community: \$100 for first place, award ribbons for second and third place
Scholar: \$50 for first place

Film Festival Event will take place on March 30, 7-8:30. Filmmakers whose films will be shown will be invited to a special get-acquainted dinner immediately before the event. Please make plans to attend the event even if you didn't place to support your fellow artists.

You further agree that credit to the artist does not have to be given in any promotion relating to the festival or church activities. You retain ownership of your work but grant rights to the festival for the various uses stated above.
